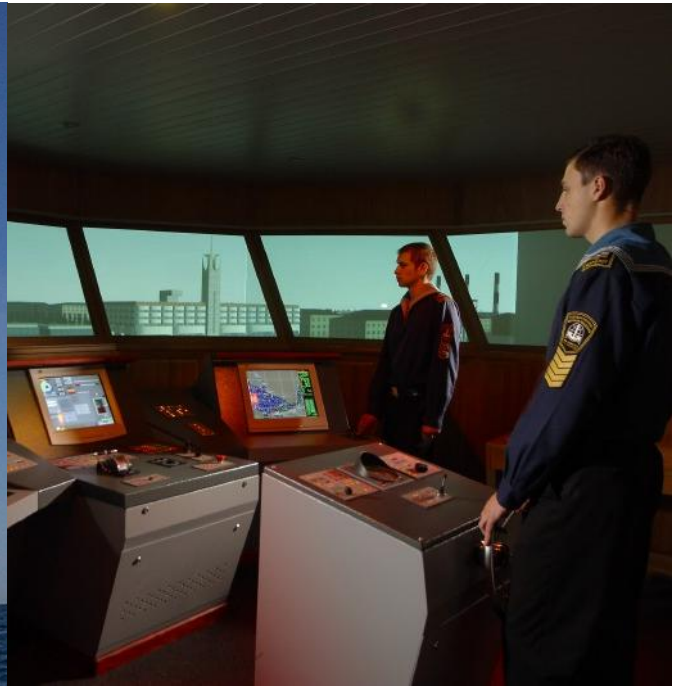




IAMUS AGA 10 CALL FOR STUDENT'S PAPERS
